ORDER:

In the circumstances stated in the reference 2nd read above and keeping in view the orders issued in the reference 1st read above, Government after careful examination, hereby issue orders fixing the following rates of remuneration payable to the staff deployed on training classes/polling/counting duties during 4th Ordinary elections to Panchayat Raj Institutions,2013 and also issue the following orders.

Presiding officers/Counting supervisors	Polling officers/Counting assistants	Class IV
Rs.250/- per day or part thereof	Rs.175/- perday or part thereof	Rs.100/- per day or part thereof

2. Besides the above remuneration lunch shall be provided only on polling day and counting day at the rate of Rs.100/- per head per day in case of difficulty in providing packed lunch.

3. In respect of Zonal Officers, Route Officers, Sectoral Officers, expenditure monitoring committees, Model Code of conduct monitoring staff shall be paid one time remuneration at a lump sum rate of Rs.800/- per head one time only.

4. In regard to the staff being drafted randomly from other constituencies covering Central Government/State Government/Banks/Insurance employees etc., specific instructions have been issued vide G.O.Ms.No.543 GA(Elec.C)Dept., dated 9.12.2005 shall be followed.

5. The Secretary State Election Commission shall take necessary action accordingly.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of GA(Elec.C)Dept., vide their U.O.No.1673/Elec.C/A1/2013-1 Dated 29.6.2013.

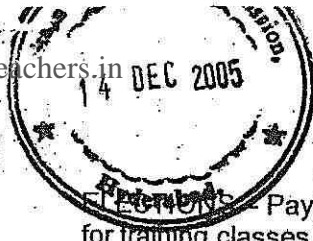

ORDER:

In the Government orders first to third read above, comprehensive orders were issued for payment of T.A./ D.A. / remuneration to the personnel drafted for training classes/counting duty, and other election work as also for provision of packed lunch or light refreshments.

2. The Government have since implemented the recommendation of Pay Revision Commission, 2005 enhancing the Pay & Allowances to the State Government Employees and revised the rates of T.A and D.A in the G.O. 4th read above. Consequently it has become necessary to revise the rates of T.A. / D.A. / remuneration payable to the personnel drafted for election work in connection with the General Elections/Bye-elections to Lok Sabha/State Legislative Assembly.

3. Accordingly Government hereby direct that the following revised rates of T.A /D.A / remuneration shall be paid to the employees drafted for training classes / counting duty / duties in connection with the Elections with effect from 29-10-2005.

4. Government also direct that revised rates of remuneration shall be paid to the employees drafted for polling duty, as shown in the Annexure to this order.

Note:

- The executive and ministerial staff of Central Govt and Public Sector Undertakings be Categorized as Grade-I, II or III for the purpose of T.A. and D.A according to their Scale of Pay
- Where polling personnel are appointed from places beyond 300 Kms such personnel may be paid D.A. and T.A. admissible to them under the normal T.A. and D.A. rules applicable to them. They are also entitled to the benefit of 1/3 DA for the purpose.
- The officers put on duty at Distribution and Reception Centres will be paid flat rates of TA and DA as in the case of Presiding Officers/ Asst. Presiding Officers/ Polling Officers with reference to the pay range applicable to them.
- The polling personnel if any, detained for polling duty beyond four days may be paid normal D.A. admissible to their grade for each extra day of duty.
- The Jeep Drivers and other drivers deputed for polling duty may be paid Rs.2.50 over and above normal D.A. admissible to them.
- Class IV employees deputed for polling duty may be paid Rs.2.00 over and above the normal D.A. admissible to them.
- The Slab shall be calculated w.r.to the actual distance for which the officer incurs transportation cost and shall not include the distance for which free transport is arranged by Election Authorities.
