The attention of the Commissioner & Director of School Education, A.P., Hyderabad is invited to the orders issued in the references 1st and 2nd cited and he is informed that in the representation 3rd cited, it has stated that some of the Junior Lecturers were appointed by transfer through School Assistant Category through DPCs conducted in the year 1998, January 2001 and September 2001. Out of them some Junior Lecturers worked as Apprentice Teachers at the time of their appointment as School Assistants and they are also eligible to get two Notional increments for their apprentice service as per the orders issued in the references 1st and 2nd cited. They have therefore requested the Government to issue suitable instructions to the Director of Intermediate Education, A.P., Hyderabad, for sanction of two notional increments for the Junior Lecturers who worked as apprentice teachers in their lower cadre, ie., School Assts. and fix the pay from time to time and payment of arrears as per the rules in force.

2. In his letter 4th cited, the Commissioner of Intermediate Education, A.P., Hyderabad has stated that the Junior Lecturers who earlier worked as Apprentice Teachers in schools and subsequently promoted as Junior Lecturers may be directed to approach the School Education Department, for sanction of notional increments for the apprenticeship period.

3. Since the subject matter of apprentice teachers pertains to School Education Department, the Higher Education (IE-I) Department have requested the School Education Department to issue necessary orders in the matter.

4. The Commissioner & Director of School Education, A.P., Hyderabad is therefore requested to consider the request of the Govt. Junior Lecturers' Association, A.P., Hyderabad and issue appropriate orders, for sanction of two notional increments to junior lecturers who earlier worked as apprentice teachers in schools, as per their eligibility, keeping in view the orders issued in the references 1st and 2nd cited.
